ONLINE WORKSHOP FOR READERS WITH PRACTICE
 The Diocesan Formation for Mission Team is currently offering two online workshops for parish readers, during June. Workshop 1 offers a general and brief introduction to the Liturgy of the Church and a more specific overview of the Liturgy of the Word at Mass, as well as an overview of the practical skills required for reading in church. Workshop 2 offers a general introduction to the Bible and a group study of a specific reading, using the 4 senses of Scripture, to equip parish readers so as to prepare and understand the depth of the texts they read. A diocesan
